Dear Parent/Guardian(s),

As of the 2010-2011 school year, the Ohio Department of Health requires all students entering the 7th grade to have a Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis adolescent and adult formulation) or Td (Tetanus and diphtheria adult) prior to the start of the school year. A new requirement for the 2016-2017 school years adds a dose of Meningococcal vaccine. The first dose is to be administered to students entering 7th grade and a second dose prior to entering 12th grade.

Every incoming 7th and 12th grade student must provide an updated immunization record to the school nurse prior to August 26th of the current year. All students must have a Tdap and/or Meningitis vaccine to get their class schedules or start school. Updated records may be mailed to the schools throughout the summer to this address:
